

Those listed must provide evidence of required skills and knowledge, plus pass a stringent onsite assessment.

- The Environment and Heritage Service for Northern Ireland
- Historic Scotland
- The National Heritage Training Group.

How to register

You can apply to join the Heritage Register by submitting a portfolio of evidence, including:

- The scope of works being carried out.
- Specification of the work being undertaken (detailed photographs of relevant work before, during and after construction).
- Details of training/qualifications held.

The Heritage Regional Representative in your area will review your application and arrange your onsite review.
