



DESIGNER ROOFING APPRENTICE OR TRAINEE

A designer roofing apprentice or trainee works alongside experienced employees to prepare designs for roofing projects. Working alongside management and estimators and attending client meetings.

This role will involve developing health and safety and IT knowledge alongside design principles.

EDUCATION NEEDED

GCSEs

The entry requirements for the apprenticeship may vary, depending on what the employer requirements are, however ideally you will have achieved a GCSE Grade C (4) or above in Maths and English.

OTHER QUALIFICATIONS

It will also help you get an apprenticeship in design if you have already achieved some further education qualifications that are relevant to the job. This could include in a design or IT related subject.

Depending on the job, the employer may look to offer an apprenticeship or a graduate trainee role where you will need a degree, or HNC or HND, in Computer Aided Design, Architectural Technology, or something similar.

WORK EXPERIENCE NEEDED

Apprenticeships are designed for those with little to no direct work experience in the roofing sector.

Employers will always value any work experience that you have gained as it builds on your employability skills. This includes part-time work, volunteering and involvement in extracurricular activities.

If you are a graduate, any relevant work experience or projects completed during your degree will also help you to stand out to employers.

- Communicate effectively and appropriately with others
- Enjoy learning how to use design technologies
- Demonstrate a positive approach to problem solving
- Show an ability to contribute to discussions as part of a team
